WORTH:

OBJECTIVE: Students will create a Trading Manual describing the political, economic, geographic, social and religious structures of the West African Trading Kingdoms.

SET UP: You are a Muslim Trader who travels across the Sahara Desert to trade salt for gold with the people of West Africa. You are creating a trading/travel manual to help others learn about West Africa and the Trans-Saharan trade so they can travel along with you on your journey.

Cover Page: You will create a cover page.

- ❑ Hand drawn picture demonstrating various aspects of West Africa that we discussed (do this LAST)
- □ Name and period at the bottom right-hand corner.

Page 1: Map of Africa. Color code the map according to the environments exactly like the map on your map challenge. The map must also have a key that labels each environment.

Label the following physical features:

- Atlas Mountains
- Sahel
- Congo Basin
- Niger River
- Atlantic Ocean
- Madagascar

- Mt. Kilimanjaro
- □ Sahara Desert
- Congo River
- Serengeti Plain
- Arabian Peninsula
- Senegal Rivee

Page 2: Describe the four different regions that make up the area surrounding the Niger River

- Label each box at the top, the four different regions.
- Describe the climate and plants that make up the area around the Niger River.
- Draw a picture for each one.

Page 3: Explain the Gold vs. Salt Trade across the Sahara Desert

- ❑ Write a paragraph (minimum 5 sentences) about the process of the salt trade (use pages in the book and the packet to help you)
- Be sure to include the vocab word: **SILENT BARTER**
- Draw a picture to illustrate it.

Page 4: This page will compare the Empires of Ghana, Mali, and Songhai.

- Fill in the chart with the appropriate information
- Use the page numbers in the book to help you

Page 5: Create a Kente Cloth to represent your family

- On your "cloth" repeat the 5 strips 3 times, in the spaces provided.
 - HINT: KEEP IT SIMPLE!
- □ Write a 3-sentence summary to explain what 3 of the 5 strips mean on your cloth

Page 6: Discuss the importance of family relationships in West African society

- Fill in the chart explaining how family hierarchy worked in a village.
- Draw a picture on the right and the explanation on the left.
- □ In the remaining box at the bottom, explain how each family member had an important role in the life of the village.
- Page 7: Discuss the influence Islam had on West African Life (use online reading).
 - Fill in the diagram to show the 3 different areas that Islam influenced West African life.
 - Include at least 2 ways in which Islam influenced each area using the lines below.
